Job Overview:

SafeWalkers will promote to students, staff, and visitors on campus about the SafeWalk program and relevant health and well-being issues, and will perform walk accompaniment duties within a 2 k.m. radius of the campus to students, staff, faculty, and visitors when requested. As well, Walkers will perform nightly safety audits of the campus, be nightly welcome ambassadors, and take detailed notes of their nightly duties.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Walkers will follow SafeWalk policies and procedures as instructed by the SafeWalk Coordinator.
- Walkers will follow the leadership of SafeWalk Captains on a nightly basis.
- Be involved in the promotion of the program (as well as relevant health and well-being issues), and help to educate the George Brown community about SafeWalk and our goals.
- Accompany students, staff, faculty, and visitors on walks to local transit stops, parking lots, or other buildings on campus.
- Respond to questions and provide excellent customer service to students, staff, faculty, and visitors.
- Maintain a daily memo book recording all duties throughout a shift.
- Conduct detailed night audits to identify potential safety hazards.
- Be knowledgeable about the campuses and surrounding areas, and familiar with ongoing events on campus.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Available to work on rotation, with a minimum availability of three nights a week.
- High degree of situational awareness and a strong mature outlook.
- Professional and reliable.
- Excellent customer service, interpersonal, verbal, and written communication skills.
- Superb organizational skills.
- Physically fit.
- Ability to work at all of George Brown’s campuses and satellite locations.



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REQUIREMENTS (continued):

- Marketing/promotional and safety experience are assets.
- Ability to speak more than one language is an asset, but not required.
