

EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF THE CHIEF RETURNING OFFICER


WHEREAS a Province Wide Emergency has been declared by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under section 7.0.1 (1) of the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*;

AND WHEREAS George Brown College of Applied Arts and Technology and the Student Association of George Brown College is operating under their respective Emergency Continued operations plans;

THEREFORE, I, CHARLES WILSON, CHIEF RETURNING OFFICER OF THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF GEORGE BROWN COLLEGE DECLARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Due to the declaration of emergency by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, an emergency exists in the opinion of the Chief Returning Officer, where this is no provision made under the by-law, elections policy, or other regulation, and the Chief Returning Officer is satisfied beyond a reasonable doubt that if adaptations are not made, a substantial number of voters would not be able to reasonably cast an informed vote.
2. The Chief Returning Officer is therefore ordering that the voting period of the 2020 spring election shall begin on **March 25, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.** and continue until **April 3, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.**
3. This declaration shall take effect upon the concurrence of the majority of the Elections Committee being delivered by email.
