



# New International Student in Post-Secondary Program Health Insurance Waiver

For new international students enrolled in the fall 2020 term at George Brown College, which runs from September 8, 2020 to December 18, 2020. Student Association of George Brown College is providing an opportunity for qualified students to request a credit/refund for the fees paid for the health insurance coverage included as part of the student's tuition payment, **if you are NOT residing in Canada during the fall 2020 term time period.**

To be eligible for this credit/refund, you must complete the following questions

- have health insurance coverage provided by Student Association of George Brown College from September 1, 2020 to midnight on December 31, 2020—in Canada or any other country;
- be able to re-enroll in the Student Association of George Brown College health insurance benefit program until January 1, 2021.
- have any travel insurance should I leave my country of citizenship (home country), including to Canada, before January 1, 2021.

In consideration of Student Association of George Brown College's agreement to provide the credit/refund referred to in the first paragraph of this Waiver, I hereby forever release and discharge Student Association of George Brown College, its officers, governors, directors, employees and agents from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, liabilities, damages, losses, costs and expenses whatsoever that I may suffer or incur or allege to have suffered or incurred, directly or indirectly, as a result of or arising from any injury, illness, disease or medical condition that I may contract, incur or suffer during the fall 2020 term, being the period from and including September 1, 2020 to and including December 31, 2020. I hereby acknowledge and confirm that I have freely, knowingly and voluntarily accepted all risk of injury, illness, disease and medical conditions that I may suffer or incur during the fall 2020 term, with full knowledge that I will not be covered or insured by any health insurance coverage arranged or provided through Student Association of George Brown College during such term.

There will be no exceptions made to the above.

- I acknowledge and understand that I am responsible for arranging my own health insurance coverage during the fall 2020 term.
- I understand that I will be charged the health insurance fee for the winter 2021 semester (January–April 2021).
- I acknowledge and understand that if I have an injury, accident or become ill, while outside of my country of citizenship (home country), during my studies for the fall 2020 term at George Brown College, that I will be personally and solely responsible for all of my medical costs.
- I understand and acknowledge that by signing this Waiver, I waive any entitlement to all health and related insurance products while continuing to attend my program at George Brown College for the fall 2020 term.
- By signing the waiver, I acknowledge and understand that I will not have life and travel insurance provided by Student Association of George Brown College.
