#### 6. Motion

Whereas the York Federation of Students & Canadian Federation of Students won the legal challenge against the Ministry of Colleges & University and the Ontario Government

Whereas the Student Choice Initiative has been deemed unlawful by the divisional court

**Whereas** the Constitution and By-Laws of the Student Association of George Brown College, 2019 defines Voting members and Non-Voting members as of October 16th, 2019, based on the framework created by Ministry of Training Colleges and University

**Be it resolved** that The Constitution & By-Laws of the Student Association of George Brown College, 2019 should be amended as follows:

#### 1. By-Law 1, Section 1 is amended as follows:

- 1. The Corporation's membership shall consist of all individuals who are either:
  - a) Currently enrolled as students of George Brown College ("the College") and either have paid the student activity fee for the current term of study; or
  - b) Belong to a category of students in respect of which the corporation has accepted a grant in lieu of such fee; or
  - c) The elected members of the Board of Directors of the corporation as defined in these by-laws; or
  - d) Currently enrolled students of George Brown College belonging to a category of students, such as full-time students on a reduced course load due to College-approved accessibility accommodations, in respect of which the corporation has

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acknowledged associated membership and negotiated the terms and conditions of membership fees

- 2. By-Law 3, Section 1(a) as amended follows:
  - a) Be a member in accordance with By-Law 1;
- 3. By-Law 12, Section 3(a) as amended follows:
- a) All members who meet the qualifications as outlined in By-law 1 shall be eligible to run.

  - 8. A motion intended for a meeting of the members from any individual member shall be placed on the agenda of a meeting of the Membership if fifteen (15) members sign a petition in support of it. The full text of the motion must be included on the petition and the text of the motion and signed petitions must be submitted to the Director of Communications and Internal a minimum of forty-five days before the meeting of the Membership. The petition refereed in this section is the same as a Membership Proposal in accordance with section 163 of the Canada Not for Profit Corporations Act. (By-laws 2019 as amended F2019, b.9, s.8)
