	- Hospitality (300 Adelaide St E)
	- Casa Loma (142 Kendal Ave)
	- Waterfront (51 Dockside Dr)
	- Daniels WF (3 Lower Jarvis St)

All locations start at 6:15 pm, but they may end at different times:
