<b>Question</b>	What is SafeWalk?
<b>Answer</b>	SafeWalk provides walk accompaniment to all students, staff, faculty, and visitors at George Brown College. Two staff will walk with you on your route.

<b>Question</b>	Where is SafeWalk located?
<b>Answer</b>	We are located on all campuses at the following locations: - St James (200 King St E) - Casa Loma (142 Kendal Ave) - Waterfront (51 Dockside Dr)

<b>Question</b>	What time do you operate?
<b>Answer</b>	St James: 7:30-70:30 pm Casa Loma: 7:30-70:30 pm Waterfront: 7:30-70:30 pm

<b>Answer</b>	<p>We walk anywhere within 2 km walking distance from your start point. This may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- TTC stops (bus, streetcar, subway)</li> <li>- Union Station</li> <li>- parking garages and lots</li> <li>- other George Brown College buildings</li> <li>- within the same building</li> <li>- for your Uber, Lyft, taxi, or car pick-up</li> <li>- the front of your home, if within 2 km</li> </ul>

<b>Question</b>	Will you wait with me at the bus/streetcar stop until the
