### **Key Functions:**

- Provide in-person service, by phone, in person and virtually online.
- Provide superior customer service while greeting students and guest and respond or referral on benefit inquiries,
- Engage in providing health referrals as directed,
- Delivery of judgement free front line and professional health support in a confidential manner
- Assist students with the health benefit policy and processes,
- Administer resource materials as directed to students
- Promoting Student Association health benefit program broadly and health and wellness campaigns.
- You will promote the health and benefit program on campus and at special events
- You will also provide administrative support to SA employees as directed.

### **General Responsibilities:**

- Provide superior in-person service to all visitors at the SA Health Benefits table office and Cleveland Clinic Canada pods on campus.
- Communicate professionally via phone and online platforms (e.g., email, live chat) while delivering accurate SA Health Benefits information.
- Work collaboratively with full-time health benefits staff, following direction on delegated tasks and assignments.
- Respond to inquiries by answering questions, directing concerns, and providing support related to health benefits programs.
- Educate students about the health plan, assist with accessing their coverage, and connect them with appropriate health benefits providers.
- Promote health benefits programs and SA events (including orientations and campus engagement opportunities) while interacting with students at tabling events.
- Support virtual clinic operations, including disinfecting equipment used by students and maintaining cleanliness of clinic spaces, while promoting virtual healthcare services.
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of physical health benefits spaces.
- Organize and manage filing systems (both physical and digital), as well as office supplies and inventory.
- Track and report data related to student engagement and services, including maintaining statistics and survey information.
- Ensure effective communication and information sharing with department staff and the program coordinator.
- Foster a wellness-centered environment that supports students' mental, physical, and emotional health.
- Participate actively in training sessions, meetings, and professional development opportunities.
- Support SA staff with additional projects and tasks as assigned.
- Attend orientations, events, and activities to promote the health benefits program.
- Other duties as assigned as required.

### **You Have:**

- Outgoing and comfortable engaging with students to promote the health benefits program
- Experience in customer service, support or reception roles, (e.g., hospitals or clinics) is considered an asset.

### **Required:**
