Subject: Important: Mandatory Health Insurance Fee for Domestic Students – Fall 2026

Attention Domestic Students Starting in Fall 2026

All full-time domestic students (some exceptions may apply*) beginning their studies in Fall 2026 are automatically enrolled in the mandatory health insurance plan and are required to pay the associated insurance fee \$378.60.

*Exceptions include:

- **Students who previously opted out:** Students who have opted out in the past have a permanent opt-out on record. As a result, they will not be charged the insurance fee in future academic years or if they enroll in another full-time program.
- **Students registered through Accessibility Learning Services (ALS):** Students with a modified course load are often identified by the college system as part-time and are therefore not automatically charged the insurance fee. However, if they are recognized as full-time through ALS, they are eligible for coverage under the student plan and must manually opt in.
- **Students whose tuition is paid by the government or a third party:** These students are generally not charged the insurance fee because it is not included in their tuition. However, if they are enrolled in a full-time program that does not follow a short-module schedule, they may be eligible to opt in to the student plan. If they are interested in accessing the plan, they need to contact the Student Association Health Benefits team by October 1, 2026.

To view your invoice online, including a detailed breakdown of your charges, please:

1. Log in to **STU-VIEW**.
2. Navigate to the **Payment Centre (Pay Fees)** card.
3. Select **Registration Letter & Invoice**.

If you have alternative extended health and dental coverage that is comparable to the student plan, you may be eligible to opt out of the plan.

The online opt-out form will be available at <https://wespeakstudent.com> until August 31, 2026, and at <https://www.alumo.ca> from September 1, 2026.

The deadline to opt out of the student extended health and dental plan is **October 1, 2026**. Requests received after this deadline will not be accepted.
