Subject: Important: Mandatory Health Insurance Fee for International Students – Fall 2026

Attention International Students Starting in Fall 2026

All international students (some exception may apply*) beginning their studies in Fall 2026 are automatically enrolled in the mandatory health insurance plan and are required to pay the associated insurance fee \$932.00.

*Exceptions include:

- **Students who previously opted out:** Students who have opted out in the past and received full-refund have a permanent opt-out on record. As a result, they will not be charged the insurance fee in future academic years or if they enroll in another full-time program.
- **Students who are international students but pay domestic tuition fees:** Those students must be covered under provincial plan (OHIP) or provincial plan (OHIP), along with an alternative extended health and dental plan
