Question	What is SafeWalk?
Answer	SafeWalk provides walk accompaniment to all students, staff, faculty, and visitors at George Brown College. Two staff will walk with you on your route.

Question	Where is SafeWalk located?
Answer	We are located on all campuses at the following locations: - St James welcome desk (200 King St E) - Hospitality concierge desk (300 Adelaide St E) - Casa Loma welcome desk (142 Kendal Ave) - Waterfront lobby desk (51 Dockside Dr)

Question	What time do you operate?
Answer	St James: 6:30-10:30 pm Hospitality: 6:30-10:30 pm Casa Loma: 6:30-10:30 pm Waterfront: 6:30-10:00 pm

Question	Where do you walk to?
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Answer	We walk anywhere within 2 km walking distance from your start point. This may include: - TTC stops (bus, streetcar, subway) - Union Station, King Station, and Dupont Station - parking garages and parking lots - other George Brown Polytechnic buildings - within the same building - waiting with you for your Uber, Lyft, taxi, or car pick-up - the front of your home, if within 2 km - front of your apartment or condo building (not inside), if within 2 km
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Question	Will you wait with me at the bus/streetcar stop until the bus/streetcar arrives?
Answer	Yes. We will assume that you would like us to wait with you until your transit vehicle arrives. You won't be left alone on the street, unless you let us know that the walk has ended.

Question	Will you help carry my stuff?
Answer	If you ask kindly, we will help you to carry your stuff.

Question	Are you hiring?
Answer	No, but we may have spots available during the year. The positions would be posted on the Student Association's web site under Jobs. Recruitment normally starts in April every year, and continues to June, when we will look over applications.

Question	Do you operate at the Theatre school?
Answer	Yes! Let us know in advance (you can call, text or WhatsApp us the same night at 1-888-210-7233), and we will have two Walkers arrive at your desired time at the front of the Young Centre for Performing Arts.

Question	Do you operate at Toronto Metropolitan University?
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Answer	No. For WalkSafe services at TMU, please call TMU Security at 416-979-5040 or email walksafe@torontomu.ca 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and a security officer will walk with you. You can also flag down a security officer if you see them to request a walk.
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Question	How can I contact you?
